8. **MOTION – LEGISLATION ON NAMING OF ROADS, STREETS,
NUMBERING OF HOUSES AND BUILDINGS, BRANDING
OF COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF BUNGOMA BUILDINGS/
FACILITIES AND VEHICLES WITH COUNTY COLOURS**

Pursuant to Standing Order 58 (1), I beg to move the following motion.

THAT, AWARE THAT the preamble of the Constitution of Kenya 2010; provides for:

1. Honouring those who heroically struggled to bring freedom and justice to our land.
2. Being proud of our ethnic, cultural, and religious diversity and determined to live in peace and unity as one indivisible sovereign nation.
3. Being respectful of the environment which is our heritage and determinant to sustain it for the benefit of future generations.

FURTHER, AWARE THAT, there is need to have clear and unambiguous rules and procedure for naming of new roads, existing roads, streets, numbering of houses and buildings and branding of County Government of Bungoma buildings/facilities and vehicles with county colours.

NOTING THAT paragraph 5 of the 4th schedule of the Constitution of Kenya, 2010 provides for the functions and power of the County on matters of County transport which includes-county roads; street lighting, traffic and parking; public road transport; and ferries and harbours, excluding the regulation of international and national shipping and matters related thereto, **FURTHER NOTING THAT**, Sub-Paragraph 8(d) of the Constitution of Kenya, 2010 provides that the functions and powers of the County include, County planning and development, including-statistics, land survey and mapping, boundaries, boundaries and fencing; housing; and electricity, gas reticulation and energy regulation.

UNDERSTANDING that The Bungoma County Flag, Emblems and Names Protection Act, 2014 provides for County Government colours which are a sense of County identity; **FURTHER UNDERSTANDING THAT**, Sec 25(I) (c) of the Heroes Act 2014 supports the recognition and honour of national heroes who can enjoy privileges amongst them having towns, institutions, and open parks in urban areas, roads, streets, estates, stamps and notable landmarks named after them; **NOTING THAT**, numbering of houses and buildings is convenient for finding addresses and also necessary for emergency response ;

I NOW MOVE AND PROPOSE that the Honourable House considers having legislation of naming of roads, streets, numbering of houses and buildings, branding of county Government of Bungoma buildings/ facilities and vehicles with county colours.
