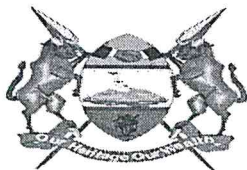

1.0. BACKGROUND

Mr. Speaker Sir,

Article 186 of the Constitution provides that the legislative authority of the County is vested in and exercised by its County Assembly. A County Assembly may make laws that are necessary for the effective performance of the County functions and while respecting the principle the separation of powers, may exercise oversight over the county executive committee and any other county executive organs.

Section 14 (1) (b) of the County Governments Act, 2012 states that; *“A county assembly may establish committees in such manner and for such general or special purposes as it considers fit, and regulate the procedure of any committee so established.”*

The County Assembly of Bungoma Standing Orders provides for the establishment of 24 committees and their mandates have been specified. Standing Order no. 174 (2) mandates the Committee on Selection to nominate members to serve in Committees, save membership of the House Business Committee, Committee on Appointment and Members of the Speaker’s Panel.

2.0. OBJECTIVE OF THE REPORT

The objective of the Selection Committee to review and place members to committees are typically for:

- a) Ensuring balanced representation to ensure that all political parties/ coalitions within the County Assembly are fairly represented across various committees.
- b) Optimizing expertise and experience to committees, where their expertise , skills and experience can be most effectively utilized leading to more informed and productive decision making
- c) Enhance committee efficiency by structuring committees in a way that promotes efficiency with members who are motivated and capable of addressing the specific issues and responsibilities of each committee
- d) Fostering collaboration and cohesion through encouraging team work and collaboration among the honorable committee members by helping to build consensus that drive collective action on key committee issues.
- e) Compliance with legal and procedural requirements by ensuring that the composition of the committees complies with all legal, procedural and constitutional requirements

These objectives informed the committee in making informed and strategic decisions that ultimately will benefit the functioning and effectiveness of the County Assembly.

2.1. METHODOLOGY

The Selection Committee used multi step method to ensure effective and fair placement of members to committees through: allowing coalitional consultations and submitting preferences and areas where they believed the members can serve better.
