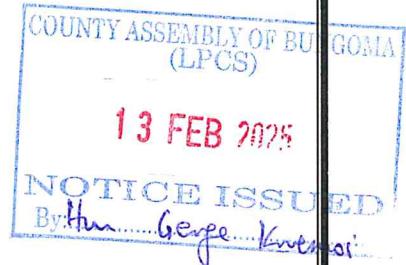

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CHAPTER ONE

1.1 PREFACE

Hon. Speaker,

The quarterly financial statements and reports for the period ended 30th June, 2024 were tabled in the House on 16th October, 2024 and committed to the committee on Gender and Culture for interrogation and reporting back to this House. The committee held interrogation with the department of Gender and Culture on Monday 4th November, 2024 and therefore submits its report herein below.

The report contains the legal framework and objectives that informed the committee to analyze the financial statements as submitted and thereafter through an interrogation process. The report also highlights the department of Gender and Culture expenditure analysis that is budget execution by programmes and sub-programmes, pending bills and outstanding imprest. Finally, it contains the committee's observations and recommendations on the financial statements and reports with respect to the department of Gender and Culture.

1.2 MANDATE OF THE COMMITTEE

Mr. Speaker Sir,

The Sectoral Committee on Gender, Culture and Social Welfare derives its mandate from the provisions of Standing Order 217 (5) of the Bungoma County Assembly Standing Orders which shall be to :

- a) Investigate, inquire into, and report on all matters relating to the mandate, management, activities, administration, operations, coordination, control and monitoring of budget;
- b) Consider quarterly reports of the assigned departments and report to the House within twenty-one (21) sitting days upon being laid;

- c) Study the programme and policy objectives of departments and the effectiveness of the implementation;
- d) Study and review all County legislation referred to it;
- e) Study, access and analyze the relative success of the departments as measured by the results obtained as compared with their stated objectives;
- f) Investigate and inquire into all matters relating to the assigned departments as they may deem necessary, and as may be referred to them by the County Assembly;
- g) To vet and report on all appointments where the constitution or any law requires the House to approve, except those under *Standing Order 204* (Committee on Appointments); and
- h) Make reports and recommendations to the House as often as possible, including recommendation of proposed legislation.

1.4 FISCAL AND LEGAL FRAMEWORK

Mr. Speaker Sir

Article 226(2) of the Constitution of Kenya, 2010 states that, the Accounting Officer of the National Public entity is accountable to the National Assembly, while the Accounting Officer of a County Government entity is accountable to the County Assembly for its financial management.

Mr. Speaker Sir.

The County Assembly discharges its oversight function on the executive through the Committee system. According to ***Section 116 of the Public Finance Management Act, 2012***, an Accounting officer for a County Government entity shall prepare a report for each quarter of the financial year in respect of the entity. Further, the Section requires the Accounting Officer to ensure that the quarterly report;

- Contains information on the financial and non-financial performance of the entity, and
- Is in a form that complies with the standards prescribed and published by the Public Sector Accounting Standards Board.

Mr. Speaker Sir. The Section also requires that not later than fifteen (15) days after the end of each quarter, the Accounting Officer shall submit the quarterly report to the County Treasury that consolidate them within one month following the end of the quarter and submit to County Assembly with a copy to National Treasury, Controller of Budget and the Commission on Revenue Allocation.

Obligations of Accounting Officers

Mr. Speaker Sir, *Section. 149(1) of the PFM Act 2012*, states that;

An accounting officer is accountable to the County Assembly for ensuring that resources of the entity for which the officer is designated are used in a way that is;

- *Lawful and authorized*
- *Effective, efficient, economical and transparent.*

Accounting officers will be accountable to County Assembly for;

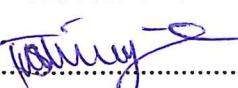
- *Ensuring the most effective means of achieving desired programme outcomes are used.*
- *Maintaining effective systems of internal control and the measures taken to ensure that they are effective.*
- *Measures taken to prepare the financial reports that reflect a true and fair view of the financial position of the department.*

CHAPTER TWO

2.1 DEPARTMENTAL EXPENDITURE ANALYSIS

Mr. Speaker Sir.

The department of Gender and Culture had an approved 2nd Supplementary budget of **Kshs. 124,614,300** comprising **Kshs. 83,243,038** recurrent and **Kshs. 40,412,749** for Development expenditure programmes.

At the end of period under review the absorption for the department was **Kshs. 91,470,715** representing 73%: recurrent expenditure was **Kshs. 71,775,403** and development was **Kshs. 19,695,312**.

2.2 RECURRENT EXPENDITURE

General Administration planning and support services

- Compensation to employees, the approved allocation was Kshs. 34,907,953 with absorption of Kshs. 31,984,863 leaving a balance of 2,923,090 which translates to 92%.

During interrogation, the department explained to the Committee that the balance of Kshs. 2,923,090 was meant for promotions of officers in the department which were not done. The Kshs. 31,984,863 was not inclusive of May and June salaries hence the allocation was insufficient, the salary requirement for May and June was not provided.

Further, the monthly expenditures on personnel was submitted as follows; Kshs. 2,476,003.30 in July, Kshs. 2,622,080.00 in August, Kshs. 2,991,280.15 in September, Kshs. 2,936,086.00 in October, Kshs. 3,641,172.20 in November, Kshs. 3,641,172.20 in December, Kshs. 3,609,611.75 in January, Kshs. 3,576,289.20 in February, Kshs. 3,571,655.85 in March, Kshs. 3,571,655.85 in April.

- Planning and budgeting with a budget of Kshs. 1,400,000 had 100% utilization in the period under review.
- Utility for office operations with a budget of Kshs. 280,000, Kshs. 109,597 was spent translating to 39% absorption rate.

- Administrative service management with an allocation of Kshs. 11,784,026, Kshs. 9,673,927 was spent representing 82% absorption rate.

Cultural Development and management programme

Under this programme, the following sub-programmes were implemented;

KICOSCA games, the department spent Kshs. 28,917,542 out of the 2nd supplementary approved budget of Kshs. 29,875,000 translating to 97% absorption rate

The breakdown on the expenditure of Kshs. 28,917,542 on KICOSCA 2023 was submitted as follows:

- ✓ Kshs.2,330,000 on KICOSCA logistics,
- ✓ Kshs. 768,000 on KICOSCA games football men
- ✓ Kshs. 488,000 on KICOSCA handball men
- ✓ Kshs. 717,500 on Basketball women team spent
- ✓ Kshs. 1,098,000 on Kamabeka team
- ✓ Kshs. 570,500 on handball women
- ✓ Kshs. 767,900 on basketball men
- ✓ Kshs. 1,829,000 on KICOSCA folksong team,
- ✓ Kshs. 446,000 on volleyball women was facilitated with
- ✓ Kshs. 1,190,000 on KICOSCA athletics,
- ✓ Kshs. 1,316,700 on medics and enforcement,
- ✓ Kshs. 1,133,300 on KICOSCA Gender and Culture department staff
- ✓ Kshs. 1,621,000 on KICOSCA netball team
- ✓ Ksh. 418,600 on KICOSCA governor's office
- ✓ EALASCA trials 2,973,000
- ✓ EALASCA games Khs. 3,067,200

On participation in Kenya Music Festival with an allocation Kshs. 500,000, the department utilized Kshs. 158,200 representing 32% absorption rate.

Hold herbal medicine day with an allocation of Kshs. 500,000. The whole amount was spent representing 100% absorption

Liquor licencing with an allocation of Khs. 1,000,000 was not expended

Construction of Sang'alo multi-purpose hall with an approved budget of Khs. 6,440,351, Khs. 6,345,642 was spent translating to 99% absorption rate. The project is at 70% completion with a pending bill of Khs. 15,395,126.40

Gender equality and empowerment of vulnerable Groups

Under this programme, the department of Gender and Culture has the following sub-programmes:

- Operations of Gender Technical working Group with an approved budget of Khs. 1,500,000 had absorption of Khs. 1,493,020 representing 100% that was spent on consultative/ engagement with GBV survivors in the ten sub-Counties and holding Gender Technical Working Groups quarterly meetings.
- Gender based violence with an allocation of Khs. 2,000,000 had 0% absorption rate. The department submitted that the programme was not carried out because no payment was made after requisition.
- International Disability day with an allocation of Khs. 1,000,000 was not spent.
- Women international day had an allocation of Khs. 1,000,000 where Khs. 1,000,000 was absorbed in celebration of Women International Day held in Mbakalo Stadium, Mbakalo ward on 8th March, 2024.
- The Women Empowerment Fund and Disability Empowerment Fund with allocation of Khs. 20,526,343 and Khs. 12,317,615 had absorption of Khs. 12,000,000 and Khs. 8,000,000 respectively that was used on clearing pending bill on construction of Masinde Muliro Stadium.

2.3 PENDING BILLS

As per the submission during interrogation, the department of Gender and Culture has a total pending bill of Kshs. 16,251,126 as shown in the table below;

2.4 OUTSTANDING IMPRESTS

As at 30th June, 2024 the department had an outstanding imprest of Kshs. 699,000.

During the interrogation, the department clarified that the imprest was meant for thanks giving prayers Kshs. 599,000 and office imprest of Kshs. 100,000. The imprest holders had surrendered but it had not been removed from the IFMIS system.

CHAPTER THREE

COMMITTEE OBSERVATIONS

Hon. Speaker,

The committee observed the following:

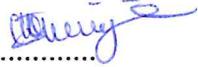
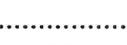
1. **THAT**, the department utilized Kshs. 12,000,000 and Khs. 8,000,000 funds meant for Women and Disability to pay for completion of Masinde Muliro Stadium.
2. **THAT**, the outstanding imprest was Kshs.699,000; Kshs. 100,000 for office imprest and Kshs. 599,000 for thanksgiving prayers which is a programme in the department of Gender and Culture.
3. **THAT**, the pending bill in the department stood at Kshs. 16,251,126 out of which Kshs. 15,395,126.40 is in respect to Sang'alo Multipurpose Hall.
4. **THAT**, on personnel emoluments, the department had an allocation of Kshs. 34,907,953 with absorption of Kshs. 31,984,863 that was not inclusive of the salaries for May and June, 2024 and a balance of Kshs. 2,923,090 was meant for promotions.

COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATIONS

1. **THAT**, the Accounting officer should comply with the provision of Section 154 (2) (c) of PFM Act 2012 on not reallocating more than 10% from one program and Section 196 (1) of PFM Act, 2012 and Section 104 (1) of County Government Act by spending funds on programs as approved in the budget estimated.
2. **THAT**, the Accounting Officer should submit a report on the status of the Women empowerment and Disability empowerment Funds.
3. **THAT**, the Accounting Officer should ensure compliance of **Regulation 93(5) and 6 of PFM Regulation, 2015** on imprest management system and he should submit a report on the action taken on the unsurrendered imprests within 14 days after adoption of this report.
4. **THAT**, the department should prioritize pending bills in budgeting and come up with a plan on how it will settle its pending bills and submit a report within 30 days from the adoption of this report

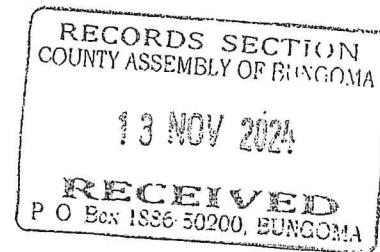
