Question No Statement

Question No. **Member for Musikoma Ward (Hon. George Makari – MCA) to seek a response from the CECM, Education and Vocational Training** in relation to questionable Financial Statements on the bursary and scholarship programmes for the FY 2023/2024. The CECM to inquire into and provide answers to the following:

1. Provide a breakdown on the expenditure of the borrowed loan of kshs. 7,715,800 which was borrowed by the Department from the Fund and the current status on its repayment.
2. State whether the said borrowing was repaid within a year from the date on which it was borrowed as per the requirements of Section 142(3) of the PFM Act, 2012.
3. Give an elaborate explanation on the discrepancies highlighted herein above in respect to the Financial Statements of the Fund during the reporting period.
4. The administrative fee for the scholarship grants and bursaries has always been 3% of the total allocation as per the Regulations governing the Fund. The CECM to provide justification for the expenditure of kshs. 5,203,660 as administrative costs which translates to 5.2%
5. Give a status report in respect to the current status of the forensic audit as ordered by the Senate Committee on Public Accounts and Investments mentioned above.
6. Provide any other information which the CECM deems relevant to the subject matter.
