3. Total number of kilogram of coffee received from farmers.
4. Dividends of cherry in terms of kilograms send to MT.Elgon millers at Chesikaki (attach delivery book)
5. Provide the milling statement
6. Sales of all cherry according to the class by cluster by new KPCU at stock exchange market
7. All bank statement capturing withdrawals and loan(s) and the names of bank signatories.
8. Total dividends of Mbuni to society and it's sales
9. Ration on how much per kg should be paid to the farmers including minutes of the meeting that made such decisions
10. Expenses incurred on development, including budget proposals, contract award, procurement process and expenditure of the 20% income earned from coffee sales.
