1. Avail details of the affected casuals as per court documents detailing what positions each one of them held and dates of employment.
2. Avail the court ruling that was delivered in their favour, detailing what action the Executive was expected to do
3. Avail the results of the physical verification exercise carried out by the Executive regarding the affected casuals.
4. What action has the executive taken after the court ruling?
5. If they have been re-instated, how many are they and in what positions have they been employed.
6. Provide the payroll prior to the court judgement and after the judgement for verification.
