Statement No Statement

Statement No. 27/2025 Member for Namwela Ward (Hon. Charles Nangulu -MCA) to get a response from the Chairperson, Sectoral Committee on Agriculture, Livestock, Fisheries, Irrigation and Co-operative Development. This is in relation to Sibumba, Kikai and Menu Coffee factories mismanagement in Namwela Ward. The chairperson to provide answers to the following:

1. List of all workers in the factory spelling out any form of advance payment(s) for their wages and pending bill;
2. List of farmers, including factory registration numbers, mobile phone numbers, any payments made to them and mode of payments used (attach documents to proof);
3. Total number of kilos of coffee received from farmers;
4. Dividends of cherry in terms of kilograms sent to the three mentioned coffee factories. (attach delivery book)
5. Provide milling statement;
6. Sales of all cherry according to class by cluster by the new KPCU at stock exchange market;
7. All bank statements capturing withdrawals and loan(s) and the names of bank signatories;
8. Total dividends of Mbuni to the society and its sales;
9. Ration on how much per kg should be paid to the farmers including Minutes of the meeting that made such decisions;
10. Expenses incurred on development, including budget proposals, contract award, procurement process and expenditures;
11. Supervisory committee report(s) and Minutes thereto;
12. Clarify on the amount of stolen/missing milled coffee in Sibumba and Kikai factories;
13. Any agreements with any firms made in the management of the factory.
