Statement No. 39/2025 Member for Kimaeti Ward (Hon. Jack Wambulwa -MCA) to get a response from the Chairperson, Sectoral Committee on Health and Sanitation. The Statement is in respect to payment of stipend to Community Health Promoters.

In the Statement, let the chairperson inquire into and elaborate on the following:

1. How much was allocated to pay stipend to Community Health Promoters in the FY 2024/2025?
2. What caused the delay in the payment of stipend to CHPs whereas there was budget for the same?
3. Now that the FY 2024/2025 has closed without their stipend being paid, explain how they are going to be paid their arrears?
4. Measures put in place by the Department to pay stipend to the CHPs on time
5. Any other information deemed necessary.

Statement No. 10/2026 Member for Bumula Ward (Hon. Hentry Nyongesa -MCA) to seek a Statement from the Chairperson, Sectoral Committee on Education and Vocational Training. The statement concerns the management and infrastructure development of Early Childhood Development Education (ECDE) and Vocational Training Centres (VTCs) by the County Government of Bungoma for the Financial Years 2023/2024 and 2024/2025.

In the response, let the Chairperson inquire into and report on the following:

1. State the total financial allocation for the construction of ECDE classrooms and ICT infrastructure specifically in Bumula Ward for the Financial Years 2023/2024 and 2024/2025.
2. Provide a detailed list of ECDE and VTC classrooms and ICT infrastructure projects completed in Bumula Ward; include the specific construction cost for each and confirm whether each facility includes standard sanitation facilities
3. State whether the constructed ECDE and VTC classrooms

- meet the minimum quality standards prescribed by the Ministry of Education.
4. Explain whether these newly constructed ECDE and VTC classrooms have been adequately equipped with necessary learning materials and furniture.
 5. State the total number of ECDE centres within the county that are officially registered under the Ministry of Education.
 6. Clarify the official pupil-to-teacher/tutor ratio as stipulated by the Ministry of Education guidelines.
 7. Provide the current actual pupil-to-teacher ratio in the county and explain if the County Government is complying with the standard of 1:25 set by the Ministry.
 8. Explain whether the construction of ECDE and VTC facilities complies with the requirements for learners living with disabilities. If not, outline the department's strategy to rectify this.
 9. State the number of ECDE teachers who have received professional training specifically to handle learners with disabilities.
 10. Scheme of Service: Confirm whether there is a functional Scheme of Service for ECDE and VTC teachers/tutors in the County. If not, explain the immediate measures being taken to establish one.
 11. Provide a comprehensive report on the status and implementation of the school feeding programme for all ECDE learners across the County.

Hentry Nyongesa -MCA) to seek a Statement from the Chairperson, Sectoral Committee on Chairperson of the Sectoral Committee on Agriculture, Livestock, Fisheries, Irrigation, and Cooperative Development. The Statement concerns regarding the management and utilization of resources allocated to Mabanga Agricultural Training Centre. In the response, let the Chairperson inquire into and report on the following:
1. State the total financial allocations for infrastructural development and the management of all programs at Mabanga ATC for the Financial Years 2023/2024 and 2024/2025
 2. Provide a comprehensive list of all projects and programs undertaken during the aforementioned Financial Years
 3. Socio-Economic Impact: Appraise the socio-economic impact of these projects and programs on the residents and farmers of Bungoma County
 4. State the total acreage of land owned by Mabanga ATC
 5. Explain how the said land is currently utilized to achieve the institution's core mandate and overall objectives

6. State the total Appropriation-in-Aid (A-in-A) or revenue realized in FY 2023/2024 and FY 2024/2025, providing a breakdown of revenue streams, including accommodation and catering services
7. Provide a list of all permanent and contracted employees, including their respective designations and job descriptions
8. State whether the ATC is operating at optimal capacity. If not, outline the specific strategic measures the Department is implementing to revamp the institute
