Hon. Hentry Nyongesa (Chairperson, Labour): Thank you, Honourable Speaker. I rise to move a motion on the Implementation Status of the House Resolution for the year 2022-2023.

Mr. Speaker: Can you confirm your membership of that Committee here? This is the second time this report is coming up and you know what happened. So, can you confirm your membership?

Hon. Hentry, based on what I have read, do you have quorum?

Hon. Hentry Nyongesa: Honourable Speaker, I have members who are on retreat on Delegated Committee.

Mr. Speaker: Which one?

Mr. Speaker: There are how many?

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Hon. Hentry Nyongesa: Hon. Stephen Kaiser, Milliah Masungu

Mr. Speaker: And Milliah Masungo

Mr. Speaker: Hon. Nyongesa, let me be clear to you now. If you don't have quorum today, I will be straight forward; the motion will come up tomorrow 9:00 a.m. If you don't raise quorum, I will make sure that this committee report does not appear anywhere in Liaison until you come.

Equally there is a Committee of Trade and Industry. It was to go out for fact finding and only one member went. Don't attempt to prepare a report arising from that fact finding. 3. ALTERATION OF THE COUNTY ASSEMBLY CALENDAR 2025

Hon. Joseph Nyongesa (Leader of Majority): Thank you Speaker, I arise to move a motion on alteration of the County Assembly Calendar 2025.

THAT aware that pursuant to the provisions of Standing Order 31(4), the County Assembly may by resolution alter its calendar from time to time, further aware that the County Assembly by resolution adopted earlier approved its calendar for the year 2025 which provided for the recess period commencing Friday 31st October, 2025 to Monday 10th November, 2025.

Noting that the House in its sittings held on Wednesday 22nd October, 2025 resolved that Tuesday 4th November, 2025 be sitting day notwithstanding that it falls within the approved recess period. Cognizant of the need to ensure that the Assembly effectively discharges its legislative, oversight and representation mandate including the consideration of urgent business pending before the House, now therefore this Assembly resolves to alter its calendar for the year 2025 by converting the period between Friday 31st October, 2025 and Monday 10th November, 2025 into a sitting week making the 4th and 5th and 6th days of November, 2025 sitting days thereby suspending the previously scheduled recess. Having reached there allow me call upon Hon. Mulongo to second. Thank you.

Mr. Speaker: Hon. Aggrey Mulongo.

Hon. Aggrey Mulongo: Thank you, Mr. Speaker, Sir for giving me this chance to second the motion. The whole House is aware that we altered our calendar last week. Therefore, with this motion that has just come before us, it is better for us to resume so that at least we can deliberate on some issues and have our House continue. Thank you.
