**REF: STATEMENT OF CHANGES TO THE BUNGOMA COUNTY FINANCE BILL, 2024**

### **Key Highlights of Changes to the Finance Bill, 2024**

1. **Schedule one from page 6 of the Bill:** Highlights Administrative fees and Changes- Prescribes penalties for financial impropriety by County Government Officers to foster integrity. No amendments were proposed on this schedule.
2. **Schedule two from page 7 of the Bill:** Agriculture, Livestock, Irrigation, Fisheries and Co-operative Development- the bill introduced new categories of charges for Maize and Livestock cess, animal sale yards, and Co-operative Audit fees. Several fees and charges were revised including; livestock sale yard, meat inspection at all slaughterhouses, subsidized fertilizers, irrigation and drainage services, fisheries, and sale of products from Mabanga ATC demonstration farm as below:
